Anchored on North Carolina's Hatteras Island in the Outer Banks village of Rodanthe, just a short drive from historic Nags Head Beach, Camp Hatteras invites Good Sam members to one of the country's most famous outdoor recreation areas. Highway 12 slices through this 10/10*/9.5-rated Good Sam Park, with the Atlantic Ocean's sandy dunes and pounding surf on one side and Pamlico Sound's tranquil estuary on the other.

The scenic highway ribbons through a postcard paradise where shorelines are never more than a few hundred yards away. You can climb up the spiral staircases at two of four local lighthouses and visit Kitty Hawk where the Wright brothers took their first powered flight.

The Atlantic's rolling waves and consistent breezes and the sound's warm, gentle waters make Camp

Hatteras a haven for fishing and water sports. It's easy to get in the swim with rental kayaks and personal watercraft right on the premises. Anglers can cast their lines in the surf, sound or three stocked fishing ponds.

Camp Hatteras welcomes Good Sam members with more than the 10 percent nightly discount. Hundreds of roomy RV campsites provide full hookups, concrete pads, cable TV and Wi-Fi. You can spend your days splashing in the surf, exploring tall dunes, playing tennis and miniature golf, and relaxing in the hot tub and indoor and outdoor pools. Activities range from water aerobics to crafts, theme weekends and ice-cream socials. The camp store can fix you up with any forgotten camping supplies.
